- 1. Have graduated with a major award in Early Childhood Care and Education at Level 7/8/9 on the National Framework of Qualifications in 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 or 2017;
- 2. Have a Qualification which is on DCYA Early Years Recognised Qualifications list
- 3. Have been working in a registered Early Years Service for two years prior to beginning their course;
- 4. Be currently working in a registered Early Years Service;
- 5. Have a copy of their graduating certificate to submit with the application form
- 6. Submit a completed application form (and a copy of the qualification certificate) to their local CCC no later than 5 pm on Tuesday 7th November 2017.

In addition:

- 7. The applicant cannot have received the Learner Fund bursary previously;
- 8. The applicant cannot have received any public funding in support of their completing the award relating to this application;
- 9. The bursary cannot be paid for post-graduate study unless the post-graduate award is specifically in Early Childhood Care and Education and on the DCYA published list.

16 th October 2017	Call for applications open by CCCs
7 th November 2017	Deadline for applications – close at 5 p.m.
